On 27 May 2022 our learners had a blast of a day! It was our swop day!

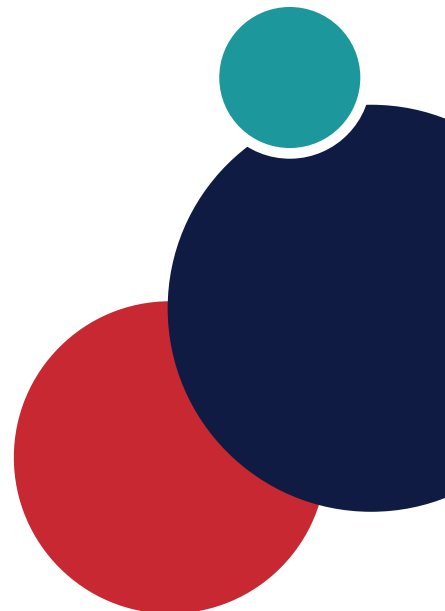
A day where learners had the opportunity to dress up as their favorite teacher and off course where teachers had the opportunity to be kids again. We also had many learners dressing up like our new school director!
